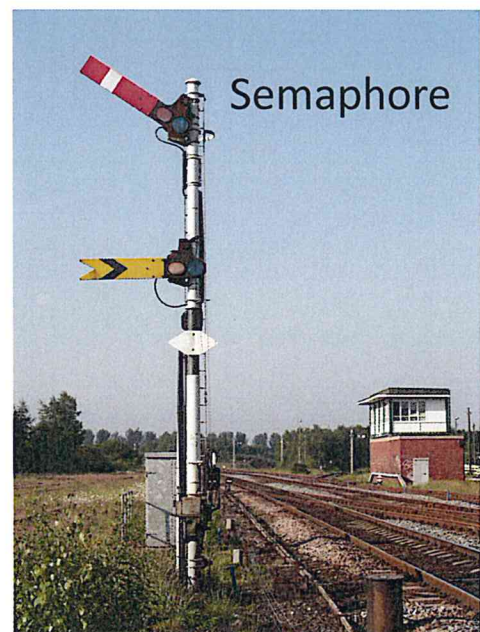
Telegraph

Try your hand at communicating as a semaphore or with the telegraph at station 1! You have to choose your words very carefully because it takes longer than

talking! If you had to choose your words very carefully all of the time, what kinds of ideas or thoughts would you share? What wouldn't you share?

Our culture has always held words in high regard. There are many Jewish themes about communication. One of the more important is the concept of *lashon hara* לשון הרע—speaking about another person. In Jewish thought, talking about other people on leads to hurt feelings and misunderstandings. Have you ever had this happen to you? Do you remember what it felt like? Judaism also has a concept of treating others how we want to be treated ourselves. Engineer Ari always uses the word *todah*, which means thank you in Hebrew. He used his words to be grateful. Let's each make a plan to be careful about how we use our words.

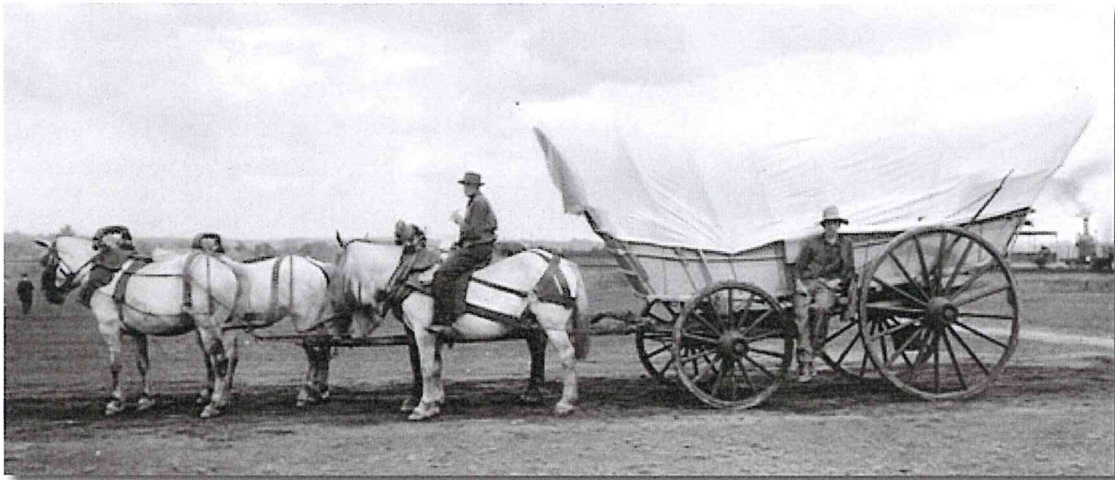


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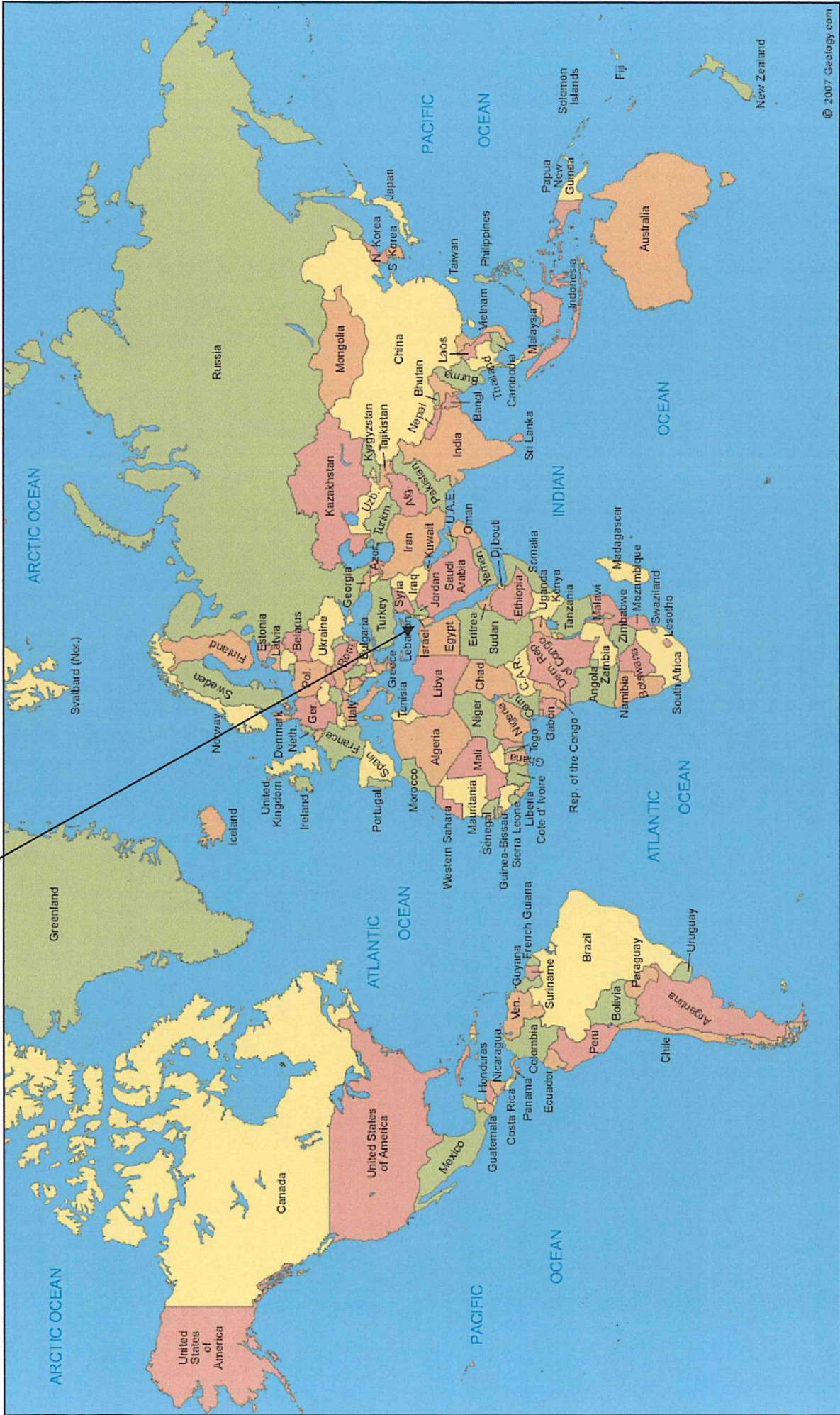
# DID YOU KNOW?

Railroads became an important mode of transportation and trade in the 1800's, both here and in Israel. The first train line in Israel started in 1892. Engineer Ari and his train carried lots of cargo from one place to the next. The trains at the B&O did the same! Before there were trains, the items were carried via ships or in a horse-pulled carriage. Do you think that the trains were faster or slower than the ships and carriages? Can you imagine waiting weeks or months for a package to arrive, rather than days?



Here in America, prominent Jewish businessmen were among the first to see the value of trains. They helped design and finance the railroad systems in Vienna, France, Belgium, Italy, Spain, Brazil, Russia, Austria, Hungary, and here in the United States. Use the map on the next page to find all of these places, and pretend that your finger is a train!
