ACCESS GRANT

Interpreter Fund

- For approved Je events in Baltimore: JADE pays \$50, 1 hour minimum
- For a series (more than 2 sessions): JADE pays half of each session, i.e. \$25 an hour, up to 12 sessions a year. The sponsoring organization pays the other half.
- For educational events at local Jewish schools: JADE pays \$45 an hour, 1 hour minimum.
- Fees get rounded up to the nearest half hour. Ex: 1 hour and 15 minute job gets paid 1 ½ hour rate.
- JADE interpreters do not charge for local travel expenses or time.
- It is the deaf or hard of hearing client's responsibility to request the interpreter, figure out who will pay for the services and then hire the interpreter.
- If the deaf or hard of hearing client does not show up, the client pays the interpreter.
