

Ebooks

- **How do I get a library subscription?**

Please send an email to jessicafink@cjebaltimore.org including the following: Your first and last name, email, phone number, mailing address, children's first name and birthdates and the name of your child's school.

- **Does the library cost money to join?**

No, it's free to community members.

- **How do I find out what my username and password are?**

Your username is your first name and last name with no spaces or capitals. Your password is your first name with no capitals (you can change the password once logged on)

- **How do I check Ebooks out?**

Go to Destinydiscover.com. Choose Maryland as the state and then Center for Jewish Education, Baltimore, MD

- **How many Ebooks can I check out at a time?**

5

- **How do my Ebooks get returned to the library?**

Ebooks are automatically returned at the end of the loan period. If you finish the book early you can return it to allow others access.

- **Can Ebooks result in fines?**

No!

- **How long do I have access to my Ebooks for?**

Picture books are 7 days. Chapter books are 14 days

- **How can I reserve an Ebook that is currently checked out?**

If there are no available copies of a title, click HOLD to reserve a copy.

- **Do I need internet access to be able to access and use the Ebooks?**

Internet access is necessary to check out books, but it is possible to download Ebooks to your browser for offline access.

- **Will we be able to check out anything besides Ebooks from the CJE?**

Our physical library is still closed at this time.

Summer Reading Program

- **Is my child eligible to participate in the summer reading program?**
Any child preschool through high school can participate.
- **What is the last day that my child can check out a book to complete the program?**
August 31st
- **How will my child be able to claim their prize?**
You will be notified when your prize is ready for pick up and will be emailed with the details.
- **When can my child claim their prize?**
Prizes will be available for pickup on Fridays - July 17, July 31, August 14 and September 4
- **What is the last day that my child can claim their prize?**
Monday, September 7, 2020
- **What books should my child read for the summer reading program?**
Your child should read books that are on their reading/content level
- **My child can't read on their own, can I read the books to them?**
Yes!
- **If my child reads more than the required number of books, can he or she be eligible for a second prize?**
No, one prize per child.
- **My children have never read Ebooks before, can we read the physical books instead?**
Yes, you may have your child read a physical book that is currently in our library collection, that hasn't been read by that child before, and is an appropriate reading/content level.
